



Moose Mountain Karate Information Sheet



2026 – 2027 classes will run from September 15, 2026, to May 25, 2027. No classes during school holidays.

Session 1 – September thru November

Session 2 – December thru February

Session 3 – March thru May

Just for Kicks (age 5, 6, 7) 6:30 to 7:15 pm

Jr./Adult (age 8 and up) 7:30 to 9:00 pm

“Grading” times may differ from regular class times and will be announced. Karateka (students) should speak to a Sensei to be excused before class is officially finished.

Fees: Just for Kicks (age 5, 6, 7)	\$80 per session
Junior (under 16)	\$115 per session
Adult (age 16+)	\$135 per session
FAMILY RATE (max 4 people)	\$250 per session

The Shintani Wado Kai Karate Federation charges an **insurance fee of \$80 per student**. This fee is **only charged once per year** in addition to the first regular session fee. It is not charged for subsequent sessions during the same “karate year”. For those registering under the Family Rate, the fee is charged for two family members only.

ALL necessary equipment can be purchased through the club, except for groin protection. Members may purchase equipment elsewhere, but it is required to meet SWKKF regulations. Gi and equipment purchased through our club assists the National Team with expenses and is generally more affordable than purchasing elsewhere.

NO FEES WILL BE DEPOSITED, OR EQUIPMENT ORDERED FOR THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF KARATE CLASSES.

After this time, any session fee refunds will be pro-rated, and equipment orders cannot be cancelled.
